First published to both critical and popular acclaim in 1955, *Pedro Paramo* represented a distinct break with earlier, largely "realist" novels from Latin America. Rulfo's entrancing mixture of vivid sensory images, violent passions, and inexplicable sorcery - a style that has come to be known as "magical realism" - has exerted a profound influence on subsequent Latin American writers. Juan Rulfo was born in Jalisco in Mexico in 1918 and died in 1986. He is the author of *The Burning Plain*, a collection of short stories. *Pedro Páramo* is his only novel. An anthropologist by profession, Rulfo is the great voice of the peasant condition.
